

NOTICE OF PROJECT SCREENING EDEN SANITARY PUMPING STATION No.1 CAPACITY UPGRADES

The Municipality of Bayham has identified that the existing Eden sanitary pumping station (Eden SPS No. 1) is approaching design capacity and requires capacity upgrades to suit future development in the settlement area. The Municipality has retained Cyril J. Demeyere Limited (CJDL) to evaluate capacity expansion options for the existing station located at 11403 Plank Road, Eden, ON. The analysis will identify the preferred method of capacity expansion to the sanitary pumping station to meet future residential growth projections.

A Stage 1 & 2 Archaeological Assessment was completed for the subject site (shown in the map below). The assessment concluded there were no items of archaeological significance found within the property limits and further investigation was not warranted. Notice of the archaeological assessment was provided to the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation (MCFN) and Six Nations of the Grand River Elected Council (SNGREC). Representatives from the MCFN were present during the site fieldwork. The archaeological assessment has been entered into the Ministry of Citizenship and Multiculturalism (MCM) Ontario Public Register of Archaeological Reports.

The Eden Sanitary Pumping Station No. 1 Capacity Upgrades Class EA Study would entail increasing pumping station capacity where new equipment is located in a new building or structure located on the existing pumping station site, not in an environmentally sensitive area. This project would previously be subject to the appropriate steps outlined in Schedule B of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) (2000, as amended in 2007, 2011, 2015 & 2023). However, under the recent 2023 amendments to the MCEA, this project is eligible for the Archaeological Screening Process (ASP). With the project being confirmed to have no negative impacts to archaeological resources, this project is considered exempt from the Class EA process.

Detailed engineering design of the Eden SPS No. 1 capacity upgrades is ongoing with construction tentatively scheduled for Fall & Winter 2024.
