AND THAT the Committee of Adjustment considered all written and oral submissions received on this application, the effect of which helped the committee to make an informed decision;

AND WHEREAS the Committee agrees that the proposed variance as presented meets Section 45.1(1) of the Planning Act and is considered minor;

THEREFORE application A-14/24 submitted by Jacob and Linda Driedger pursuant to Section 45 of the Planning Act for a minor variance, is granted to allow relief from Municipality of Bayham Zoning By-law No. Z456-2003, specifically:

 Section 10.5 <u>Maximum Building Height</u> - to permit a maximum building height of 8.0 metres for the development of a new single-detached dwelling, whereas 7.0 metres is permitted in the R1 Zone.
